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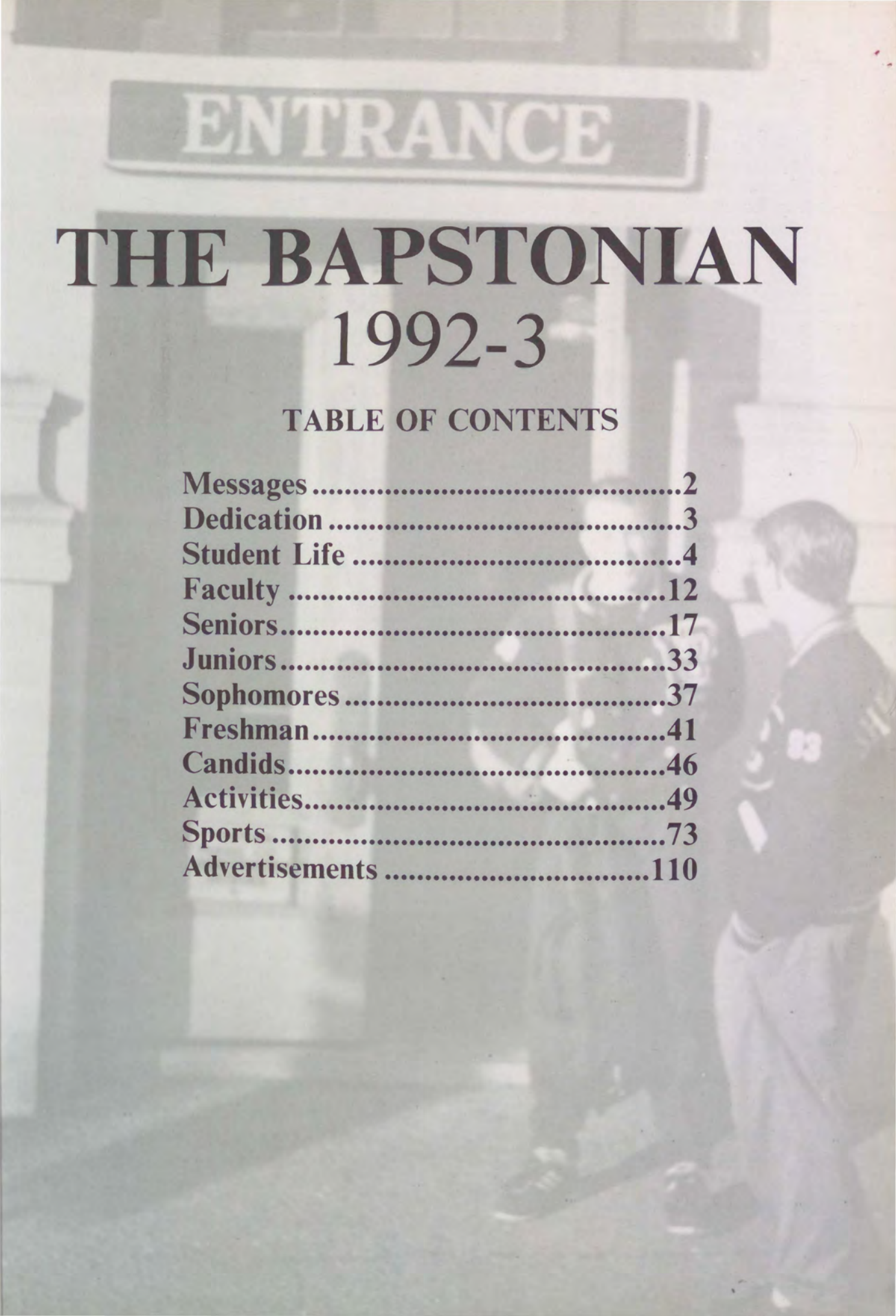

longer than the daily struggles I have faced.

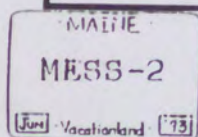
With any luck, in the future this book will remind you of your friendships, those that have faded and those that endure.

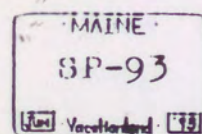
